Sharewear provide Clothing, bedding and shoes to those in crisis in Nottinghamshire. They run on a referral scheme, just like a food bank, with referral centres and collection and distribution points throughout the county. They were set up in March 2014 by a group of 5 Christian women, who witnessed clothing poverty in their parishes and took action, with Matthew 25:36 'I was naked, and you clothed me' as their inspiration. They now have a dedicated band of 50 volunteers and 10 trustees working out of their new premises in Daybrook. Their mission statement is 'To provide clothing with compassion'.

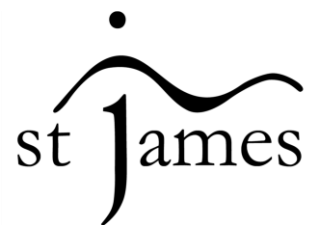
